





Application Process

Interested students should submit their cover letters, resumes, and portfolios to careers@boxelstudio.com email address.



Eligibility

The internship program is open to students <u>currently enrolled in an</u> <u>accredited college or university</u>, with a focus on visual effects, animation, or related fields.



Duration

The internship will typically last for <u>3-6</u> <u>months</u>, with flexible start and end dates that align with the student's academic schedule.



Work Schedule

Work Schedule: Interns will typically work <u>full-time</u> during the internship, with a schedule that aligns with the company's regular business hours.



Compensation

Compensation: The internship will be <u>unpaid</u>, but students will have the opportunity to gain valuable industry experience and may be <u>considered for</u> <u>full-time employment after the</u> <u>completion of the program</u>.

Responsibilities

Interns will work closely with the VFX team, assisting with various aspects of the VFX production process, such as compositing, 3D modelling, texturing, and lighting.



Confidentiality

Interns will be required to sign a **confidentiality agreement (NDA)**, agreeing not to disclose any confidential information about the company or its clients during or after the internship.



Supervision

Interns will be supervised by a designated <u>mentor or supervisor</u> who will provide guidance, feedback, and support throughout the internship.



Evaluation

The company will provide regular feedback to the interns and evaluate their performance at the end of the internship.



Expectations

Interns are expected to be professional, reliable, and eager to learn. They should be able to work well in a team and take direction well. They should also be able to take initiative and be proactive in finding solutions to problems.


Cover letter requirements:

We would like to request that you submit a cover letter along with your application, which should include the following information:

- 1. An introduction of yourself and your background in the visual effects' industry.
- 2. A clear explanation of why you are interested in the internship and how it aligns with your career goals.
- 3. A description of your relevant skills, knowledge, and experience in the field of VFX.
- 4. A demonstration of your passion for the visual effects industry and your desire to learn and grow as a professional.
- 5. Any additional information that you believe will help us to understand your qualifications and suitability for the program.

We look forward to reviewing your application and cover letter, and learning more about your background and qualifications.

<u>P.S.</u> Please make sure to submit your cover letter in a professional format and please proofread before submitting, that will demonstrate your attention to detail and professionalism.



New Boxel artist application

Reel requirements:

- 1. A clear, concise, and well-organized reel that showcases the applicant's skills and abilities.
- 2. A variety of examples of the applicant's work, including at least one example of compositing, 3D modelling, texturing and lighting, and animation.
- 3. A demonstration of the applicant's understanding of visual effects techniques and processes, as well as a good understanding of the industry's standard software.
- 4. High-quality visuals, that are polished, and demonstrate attention to detail.
- 5. Good use of sound and music, if applicable.
- 6. A duration of no more than <u>3 minutes</u>.
- 7. The reel should be properly labelled with the software and techniques used in each shot.
- 8. The reel should be in a format that is easy to view and download, such as a link to a website or a file hosted in a cloud service.

<u>Note for the applicant:</u> It's important to keep in mind that a demo reel is often the first point of contact with the company, so it's important to make a good impression and showcase the skills and knowledge that make the applicant stand out from the crowd.
